

## Advertisement for Prime US Director/Clinical Faculty position

The University of California San Francisco (UCSF) invites applications for the position of Director of the Program in Medical Education for the Urban Underserved (PRIME -US), an innovative program designed to prepare participating medical students to become leaders in undeserved health care. The successful candidate will be appointed in the Clinical X or HS Clinical professor series, at the Assistant, Associate or Professor level, dependent upon qualifications and experience.

The PRIME-US Director is responsible for directing curriculum, mentoring, and advising activities for participants at UCSF and the Joint Medical Program (JMP). The PRIME-US Director reports to the UCSF School of Medicine's Associate Dean of Curriculum.

The successful candidate will commit 50% of their effort to the PRIME-US Director position and 50% to clinical and educational activities in the appropriate clinical department. Candidates should have demonstrated abilities to inspire others and to work collaboratively, develop programs, mentor students and faculty, teach effectively, and provide outstanding clinical care to urban underserved communities. Experience with program administration is preferred.

### Minimum Qualifications:

- Board-certified in Family & Community Medicine, Medicine, or Pediatrics
- Experience in working in an urban underserved setting
- Demonstrated leadership in curriculum administration and medical education
- Demonstrated passion for teaching, mentoring, and student development
- Outstanding oral and written communication skills

### Desired Qualifications

- Proficiency in a second language such as Spanish, Mandarin, or Cantonese
- Fellowship or advanced degree in related fields
- Demonstrated publications or impact in related fields
